Major Challenges – direct reporting issues

- Financial Literacy
 - Challenge of raising the bar v simplifying
 - Directors as Users
- Proportionality
 - Cost v benefit
 - Valuation...Administered & Controlled Assets
- Nonprofit Myths
 - Surplus v profit
 - Reserves





Major Challenges – extended issues impacting financial governance:

- Lack of governance experience
- Volunteer directors: little industry knowledge
- Retired volunteer directors: not up to date
- Lack of administrative resources
- Regulatory compliance a priority
- Acquittal to specific funders
- "Tick the box" governance:

"[We are]...on autopilot to be honest, sort of rinse and repeat from last year, you know, from every previous year." Participant

- Universal recognition of accountability
- ACNC Standard Chart of Accounts
